### How it can be used

#### Bedding and Turfing

For best results work 2-3 inches of Soil Improver into the top 6-9 inches of soil. This combination will greatly improve the performance of shallow rooted plants and grasses. Soil Improver has a good moisture retention capacity and will therefore reduce watering requirements and plant stress.

#### Trees and Shrubs

For best results mix one part Soil Improver with one part soil. This combination will create the ideal conditions for heavy root development, ensuring a higher success rate for the young tree and shrub.

#### Top Dressing

For lawns, sports fields and golf courses. Being relatively low in nitrogen it will not cause excessive growth but will still add vital nutrients and humus to the turf.

• Nitrogen (N)	14gms/litre
• Phosphorus (P)	2.4gms/litre
• Potassium (K)	8gms/litre
• PH	8.0

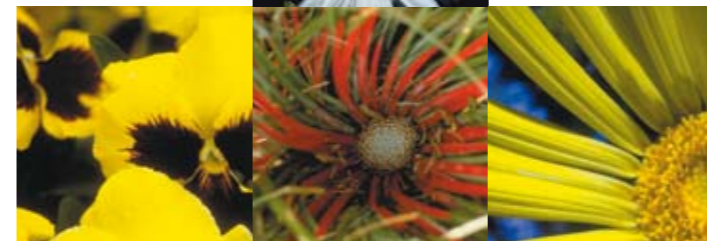

### Where to use

- Apply evenly (50mm) on the surface garden bed or around the trees or shrubs.
- Avoid placing mulch against the tree trunk or main leader of the shrub.
- Once applied, the mulch may be watered in to help keep it in place and to help leach out any excess salts.
